

Supporting. SAFE LANES IN PENDLESIDE

Following the decision by Villagers to concentrate on the upkeep of Thorneyholme to Old Hall we are most grateful to the residents who responded

with improvements in and around their erties. Judging for the second phase of the 'Best Kept' competition takes place in the first couple of weeks in August so we are appealing to all to do their bit. Not only are we hoping to win but we are trying to achieve an increased sense of pride in our Village whereby residents take more ownership of their surroundings, be it pulling up the odd weed, sweeping up or simply cleaning their street signs. The Parish Council constantly try to do their bit, taking on jobs themselves;- most benches and bus shelters have had a lick of paint, the river has been cleared and some traffic signposts have been painted black. We also organise outside agencies to assist, ie. more grass is being cut than ever before and for the first time in many years we had a visit from the small street sweeper and this will now come on a regular basis.

The introduction of the new 'recycling' scheme has brought a few problems, particularly in areas. It is settling down now but if anyone has a ongoing problem please speak to a Parish Councillor.

The Village Fayre in June was most enjoyable and rewarding. Thanks to all for coming, for donating and for participating.

Our quest for grants continues and we have recently been awarded £8350 for the kitchen extension at the Village Centre. We are still working on funding Phase II of the riverside wall.

Construction of the Water Treatment Works has now started, but early surveys have shown that additional works are necessary that are going to have a major impact here. These include the installation of new pipelines from Thorneyholme to Whitehough; from Ridgaling to Newchurch via Ridge Lane, Dimpenley & Barley Banks and even the possibility of taking a electricity supply from Stang Top, through the village and up Pasture Lane. The Parish Council are in close contact with the contractors and have organised a public meeting where further details will be given.


